Did you know?...On the north side are four panels dedicated to the women of the Bible? *THE CROWN AND SCEPTER* for Miriam - symbols of power. She shared authority with Moses in leading the children of Israel.

THE WHEAT AND SICKLE for Ruth symbols of her gleaning in the fields of Boaz. THE DISTAFF (a spindle with wool on it which was the early means of making thread) for Elizabeth, the mother of John the Baptist -- symbol of industry.

THE DOVE OF ANNUNCIATION for Mary, the mother of Jesus -- symbol of the Holy Spirit which came upon Mary at the announcement of Jesus' birth.

~ We trust you have enjoyed learning the stories of our stained glass windows. But ... There is one more window to be looked at. In the center window on the south side, you will see a special panel. Notice the red border. The border runs down from the upper left corner, across the bottom, and back up. In all the other windows, the border runs from the bottom left up across the top and down. This may look like a mistake, but it is not. The border signifies that we, as humans, are imperfect and make mistakes. Only God is perfect!
